In the space of one-parameter families of *G*-equivariant vector fields, there is an open set *V* with the following property: If $X_{\lambda} \in V$, then there is a bifurcation of the origin at $\lambda = \lambda_0$ such that

(a) the origin loses stability as λ increases through λ_0

(b) for $\lambda > \lambda_0$, there is a stable heteroclinic cycle near the origin.
